Hello, and thank you for your interest in a PatchDisplay.

For the display to look its best, it is a good idea to purchase new patches if they are available from your Council Scout Shop. If you choose to use badges and patches that are already sewn onto something, then please remove them before sending them to me.

Here is a list of the items that are typically included:

- Your home council shoulder patch
- Your Troop neckerchief, or an Eagle Scout neckerchief
- Unit numerals. Using red/white or green/tan should depend on what was used during your path to Eagle.
- All merit badges (Remember to take either an Advancement Report, your merit badge sash, or all merit badge cards with you to your Council Scout Shop. It is the only way they will sell the merit badges directly to you.)
- World Conservation Award
- All rank patches INCLUDING THE EAGLE RANK PATCH
- Cub Scout Arrow of Light patch
- All Troop position patches (Scribe, Den Chief, Patrol Leader, ASPL, SPL, JASM, etc.)
- OA sash and pocket flap
- Patches from training (NYLT, etc.)
- God and Country medals
- 50-miler patch (the leather version looks best on the display due to size and detail)
- High Adventure Base Patches (Philmont, Northern Tier, Sea Base, Summit)
- Mile Swim, Snorkel, Scuba patches
- Summer camp facility patch
- Other Trip Patches (NOAC, Jamboree, Conclave, skiing, canoeing, etc.)

Please send me all items to the address below. If you have a lot of items in addition to your ranks, positions, and merit badges, please indicate priority by putting the most important items in a zip-top bag marked, "1," less important items into a bag marked, "2," and optional items into a bag marked, "3."
